Lucy was known for her work as a patient leader, disability activist and palliative care advocate for young people who, like her, had a life limiting illness. She devoted her life for the fulfilment of rights for disabled and/or chronically ill individuals and their carers, to improve health and social care services for a better patient experience.

In 2019 we first came across Lucy
Watts in a guidance document by
the Open University and Together
for Short Lives entitled 'Talking
about sex, sexuality and
relationships: guidance and
standards for those working with
young people with life limiting or
life-threatening conditions.

Lucy subsequently became a storyteller for Saint Francis Hospice at our Schwartz Round to demonstrate how young people who are very unwell still need intimacy when facing the end of their life. The round resonated with Hospice staff enabling them to speak openly about their experiences when those they supported expressed their need for intimacy, a conversation that may not have been explored previously.
