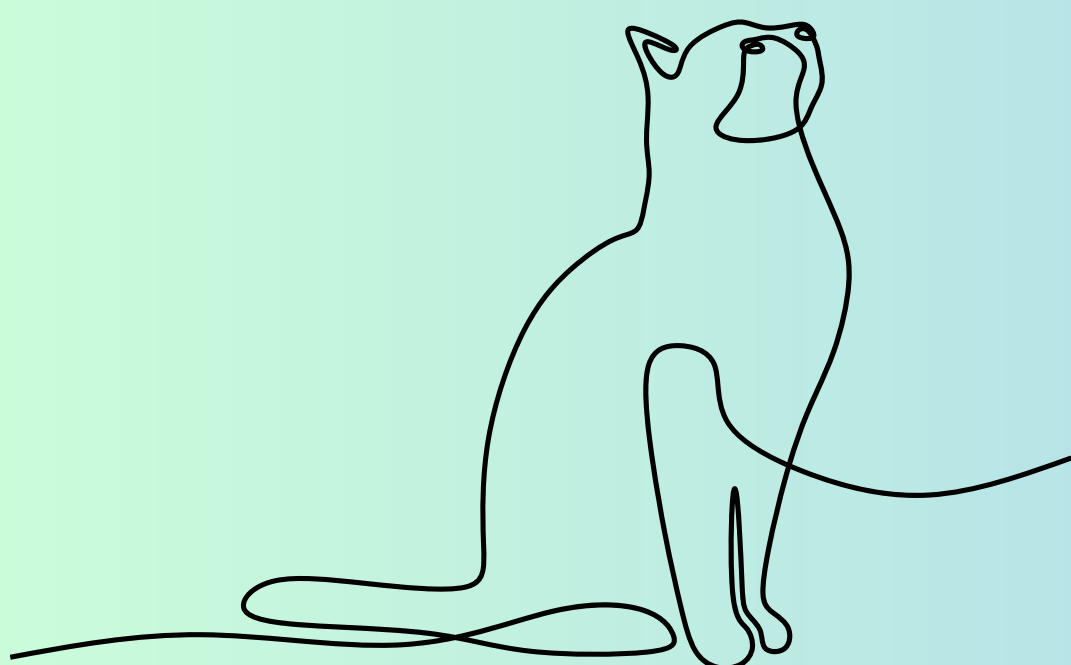
MOVE TO ONLINE SCHWARTZ ROUNDS DUE TO COVID-19
